Colonel Anthony (Tony) D. Krogh is the CSL selected Director of the Army's National Simulation Center (NSC), a 300 person organization that serves as the Army's proponent for training simulation. He is additionally responsible as the TRADOC Capability Manager of the Live, Virtual, and Constructive (LVC) Training Environment with oversight to integrate all LVC components for home station training and leads the Army's capability developers for constructive simulations, gaming, and LVC integrating architecture by representing the user community and articulating capability requirements.

Colonel Anthony (Tony) D. Krogh was commissioned through ROTC as a Distinguished Military Graduate into the Corps of Engineers in 1986. He has a Bachelor's of Science degree from University of Alabama, a Master's Degree in Management from Troy University, and a Master's Degree in National Resource Strategy from the National Defense University. Colonel Krogh is a graduate of Airborne School, Engineer Officer Basic Course, Ranger School, Infantry Officer Advanced Course, Combined Arms Services Staff School, Command and General Staff College, Simulation Operations Course and the United States Industrial College of the Armed Forces.
